## **Amendment No. 2**

**to Annex 4 of the PEFC Council Technical Document (17 June 2005):**

### **Chain of Custody of Forest Based Products – Requirements**

The PEFC Council General Assembly decided on 31 October 2008 to amend Annex 4 of the PEFC Council Technical Document as follows.

**3.4.2.1** The volume credit shall be distributed to the output products in a way that the certified products will be considered as including 100 % of certified raw material.

Note: If the certification percentage for the production batch consisting of 100 tonnes of output products is e.g. 54 % then 54 tonnes of the output products can be sold as certified products including 100 % of certified raw material.

**3.4.2.1** The volume credit shall be distributed to the output products in a way that the certified products will be considered as containing 100 % of certified raw material or as containing less than 100 % certified raw material and meeting the organisation's own threshold. The result of the volume of certified products multiplied by the output percentage of certified raw material included in the certified products shall be equal to the applied volume credit.

Note: If the certification percentage for the production batch consisting of 100 tonnes of output products is e.g. 54 % then the volume credit is 54 tonnes of the output products. The organisation can either sell 54 tonnes as certified products including 100 % of certified raw material or x tonnes as certified products including y % of certified raw material, where  $x * y =$  applied volume credit. (e.g. 77 tonnes of output products can be sold as certified products including 70 % of certified raw material, where  $77 \text{ t} * 0,70 = 54 \text{ t}$ ).
