



Forest Management and Chain of Custody Certification Reassessment of Správa Krkonošského národního parku, Czech Republic 17-19 April 2024

Introduction – Preferred by Nature is conducting forest management and chain of custody certification reassessments of the Správa Krkonošského národního parku located in Czech Republic. The reassessment will be implemented from 17-19 April 2024.

Scope of the Certification Assessment – The forest management certification reassessment will assess the environmental, silvicultural and socioeconomic aspects of the forests managed by Správa Krkonošského národního parku, using the The FSC Forest Stewardship Standard for the Czech Republic FSC-STD-CZE-02-2024 EN. Standard is available at: <https://connect.fsc.org/document-centre/documents/resource/1488>. Preferred by Nature is accredited by the Forest Stewardship Council™ (FSC™) and this reassessment process must follow procedures which have been approved.

The forest under evaluation contains areas either identified as High Conservation Value Forests or where high conservation values, as defined by the FSC, are likely found. Preferred by Nature evaluates the identification, management and protection of these High Conservation Values and solicits related comments from stakeholders.

Assessment Team Composition – The reassessment will be led by Juraj Tužinský from Slovakia. The team members will be: auditors Michal Mikoš (Slovakia), Ines Lasala (Czech Republic).

Assessment Steps and Schedule – Following is a short description of the certification process and a tentative agenda:

- ◆ **Assessment organization** – The reassessment start in Vrchlabí on 17 April 2024.
- ◆ **Field assessments** – The auditor will visit sites managed by Správa Krkonošského národního parku from 17 to 19 April 2024
- ◆ **Stakeholder consultation** – Throughout the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders regarding forest management of Správa Krkonošského národního parku. This will include private interviews and discussions, and public stakeholder meetings.
- ◆ **Public stakeholder meetings** – A public stakeholder meeting will be held in Vrchlabí. Date, time, and location will be announced soon.
- ◆ **Final assessment briefing** – Prior to departure auditor will meet with Správa Krkonošského národního parku and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- ◆ **Draft report production** – The auditor will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to Správa Krkonošského národního parku. This should occur 25 days after completion of the reassessment.
- ◆ **Certification decision** – Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from Správa Krkonošského národního parku and other general stakeholder comments, Preferred by Nature will reach a certification decision. Barring unforeseen obstacles, this should occur by 15 May 2024.

Your Input Sought – As a part of the forest certification reassessment process we invite stakeholders to offer comment and feedback on Správa Krkonošského národního parku forest management in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above as well as comments on the FME's management and protection of High Conservation Values within the forest under evaluation. We welcome input, either public or confidential, in whatever form is easiest and most secure for you. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the assessment process, but we would prefer to receive your comments either prior to the assessment, during the assessment so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision. Your options for communicating your observations to us are as follows:



1. Meet with a Preferred by Nature auditor during the fieldwork.
2. Call and give comments to Juraj Tužinský, Preferred by Nature staff person responsible for coordinating this certification reassessment.
3. Submit written comments by mail or email to Juraj Tužinský.

Unless you request otherwise, these comments will be kept confidential and are solely for the purposes of assessing the Správa Krkonošského národního parku. The source of any information provided will be kept confidential available to only to FSC and Preferred by Nature staff.
